On June 23rd the SCTE named Reni Gorman, an award-winning expert in performance improvement and learning strategies, as the organization's first Vice President, Learning and Development.

Description:

Ultra High Definition TV (UHDTV) has arrived – no ifs, ands, or buts. UHD (as it is more accurately described) provides images with at least four times the resolution of 2K, and multiple iterations will eventually take resolution to 8K. The convergence of large, inexpensive LCD displays with improved video codecs, expanded streaming of content, new backlighting systems, and high frame rate / high dynamic range video production is creating a vastly different television system than what we have now.

This webinar will get attendees up to speed on the state-of-the-art of 4K, including the different UHDTV format definitions, applicable display technologies for direct-view and projection, content storage and delivery requirements, bandwidth issues, display interfacing and switching challenges, and codecs (H.264 vs. H.265).

Are you interesting in becoming an SCTE Certification Proctor?

Q: How do I become an SCTE certification proctor?

A:Follow these four steps to apply to become an SCTE certification proctor:

- 1. Check the Proctor Eligibility Requirements
- **2.** Read the Online Certification Handbook
- 3. Agree to the SCTE Proctor Code of Ethics and the Proctor Confidential Information Agreement
- 4. Complete the Online Proctor Application

SCTE Proctor Tips

In order to proctor the online certification exams, you need a proctor ID and password.

- The proctor's username always begins with "P" followed by the proctor's SCTE 6-digit member ID. (Note that this may require a leading zero.)
- The proctor's password is the same password used to login to the SCTE website.

It is critical that you do not disclose this information to anyone. One of a proctor's highest priorities should be maintaining the integrity of the certification program. Without this, the certification has little value.
